Frequently Asked Questions: MAF Bond 2.0 Artist Roster

Can I hand deliver, mail, or email my application?

No. All applications must be submitted using Submittable, our online submission system. We are unable to accept and will not review email or paper submissions.

Does the online application have to be completed in one sitting?

No. Once you have created a Submittable account, you may save your work and return to the form later but before the deadline.

What do I need to complete my application?

Before you begin your application we recommend gathering your materials. You will need the following items:

- 1 page resume or CV
- Up to 8 images of previous completed artwork (no renderings)

Are you registered as a city vendor in iSupplier?

To do business with the City of Atlanta artists, businesses, and organizations must register for the City of Atlanta [iSupplier](#) account. We recommend doing this in tandem with your application for the roster.

I am having problems submitting my application?

What if I make a mistake on my application?

If you need to amend your application in any way, you can log into your Submittable account and make changes to your submission. You can edit, withdraw, or resubmit your application any time before the deadline.

What is the selection process?

The MAF Bond 2.0 Artist Roster will be used to prequalify artists, businesses, and organizations for upcoming projects. Applicants will be evaluated solely on their demonstrated ability to execute commissions based on previously completed artworks and projects. Applications will be evaluated based on ability not aesthetics, and categorized by medium and size. There is no guarantee that artists on this roster will receive a commission.

Can I submit a combination of past work and proposal images for my work samples?

No. You can only submit images of previous works. No renderings or proposal images will be accepted.

Is the call limited to Atlanta-based artists only?

Artists from anywhere in the United States are encouraged to apply.

Can I apply as part of a collaboration or artist team?

Yes. We have a separate application for organizations, businesses, visual arts project managers, and arts administrators who can show that they have completed previous public art projects.

Will I receive correspondence from the Mayor's Office of Cultural Affairs after applying to the MAF Bond 2.0 Artist Roster?

Yes. All applicants who apply should receive a notification email confirming the receipt of the application.
